Monday	<p>Objective: Become familiar with Photoshop Toolbars</p> <p>Activities: Introduction to Photoshop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quick reference card • Liquefy Tutorial--grade <p style="text-align: center;">Liquefy Your Image</p> <p>One of the most powerful additions to Photoshop is the Liquefy tool. In essence, it turns images into Silly Putty. You can turn a beautiful swan of a girl into an ugly mutant at the click of a button. But it can also be a very serious tool.
